A Hand Up

A Hand-Up is an opportunity for a paid days' work for individuals who are homeless, unemployed and/or panhandling. Individuals work as a part of a clean-up crew and are paid at the end of each day. Case management and employment support are offered to participants.

Outreach

Amos House's Outreach Team works with unsheltered men and women who are at risk for violence, providing them with vital supplies, case management, and access to housing and recovery services. We also provide Naloxone and other anti-overdose supplies.



Recovery Shelter Housing

If you are experiencing homelessness and struggling with substance use disorder, we can help. Our 90-Day Recovery Shelter Housing offers a safe place to stay while you focus on recovery. Intake appointments are each Thursday from 10-12.



Vocational Training

Are you unemployed or underemployed? Our Vocational Training Programs can help you prepare for and find steady work. From culinary to carpentry and beyond, our Job Training programs offer both classroom instruction and hands-on experience that prepare people for the changing job market.
